



Teen Living Programs

Bronzeville Youth Shelter

The BYS provides minor-aged youth, ages 14-17, with a safe, supportive, and temporary place to stay while efforts are made to reunite them with their families or secure alternative living arrangements. The 4-bed emergency shelter provides housing, crisis intervention, case management, supportive services, and meets the youth's basic needs.

- Located in Chicago's Bronzeville community, we serve homeless youth in the Chicagoland area as well as Out-of-State youth
- Youth are typically referred to the BYS through CCBYS (Comprehensive Community Based Youth Service) agencies, however we do accept youth from DCFS (if a ward of the state) and Chicago Police (if youth is a Out of State Run-away)
- Provides emergency shelter for up to 21 days

Belfort House

Located in Chicago's Bronzeville neighborhood, TLP's Belfort House is a 24-bed transitional living program for young people between the ages of 18 and 21. Youth are engaged in productive activities including school, employment, and life skills training. With staff support, youth create Individual Action Plans which serve as road maps to help them achieve their goals while residing at Belfort House.

- Provides housing for up to 18 months
